Prefer is a verb which means you like something better than something else.

I **prefer** Vietnamese food **to** McDonalds.

When you are expressing preferences, you can also compare one thing to another.

I **like** hamburgers **more than** rice.

I **don't like** McDonalds **as much as** KFC.

For example

I prefer dumplings to hamburgers.

OR I like dumplings more than hamburgers.

OR I don't like hamburgers as much as dumplings.

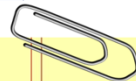
